**JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF AGREED UPON ORDER RESOLVING MOTION OF WEBSTER BANK, N.A. FOR RELIEF FROM THE AUTOMATIC STAY, AND DEBTOR’S OBJECTION TO SUCH MOTION AND TO CANCEL EVIDENTIARY HEARING**

Webster Bank, N.A. (“Webster Bank”) and the debtor in the above-referenced bankruptcy case, Joseph F. Perroncello (the “Debtor”) (collectively, the “Parties”) hereby submit this Joint Motion for Entry of the Agreed Upon Order Resolving Motion of Webster Bank, N.A. for Relief from the Automatic Stay, and the Debtor’s Objection to Such Motion (the “Agreed Upon Order”) and to cancel the evidentiary hearing set for March 24, 2011 at 11:00 AM.

In support thereof the Parties state that:

1. On November 3, 2010, the Debtor filed a voluntary petition under Chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code.
2. On November 23, 2010, Webster Bank filed its Motion for Relief from the Automatic Stay (“Motion for Relief”) [Docket No. 60].
3. On December 7, 2010, the Debtor filed his Objection to Webster Bank’s Motion for Relief (the “Objection”) [Docket No. 73].

4. On December 21, 2010, this Court entered an Order scheduling an evidentiary hearing on Webster Bank's Motion for Relief on March 24, 2011 at 11:00 AM (the "Evidentiary Hearing").

5. The Parties have reached a resolution with regard to the Motion for Relief and the Debtor's Objection, which is set forth in the Agreed Upon Order filed herewith.

6. The Parties request that the Court enter the Agreed Upon Order and cancel the Evidentiary Hearing.

WHEREFORE, the Parties jointly and respectfully request that this Court (i) enter the Agreed Upon Order Resolving Motion of Webster Bank, N.A. for Relief from the Automatic Stay, and Debtor's Objection to Such Motion, and (ii) cancel the Evidentiary Hearing that is currently scheduled for March 24, 2011 at 11:00 AM.
